

Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd. Speed Championship Rules

1. The championship will be administered by the speed championship coordinator. This is currently Mervyn Brake, contact details can be found elsewhere in the club magazine or web site.
2. The championship year will run in line with the club year, from 1st October to 30th September.
3. The championship will comprise all speed events run by Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd in the club year. There are currently five – the April Wiscombe double-header, the July National Wiscombe and the September Charmouth double-header. The club reserves the right to add or delete events if necessary; any such changes will be publicised in the club magazine and web site.
4. Competitors are not required to register with the speed championship coordinator, but points will only be scored where entries are made under Woolbridge Motor Club and shown as such in the entry list.
5. A competitor's best scores from one less than the number of events run will count, e.g. the best four from five events.
6. Class winners will score ten points; other contenders score ten points less the time difference from their class winner. For example, a competitor 1.3 seconds slower than the class winner will score 8.7 points.
7. Classes will be as run on the day of each event. There will be no re-classification into standard classes or specific regional championship classes.
8. Ties will be decided in favour of the competitor with the most class wins. If this does not resolve a tie, the winner will be the competitor with the greatest time margin over other competitors in the class. For example, a competitor with three class wins winning the class by 2, 3, and 4 seconds, and 2 seconds behind the class winner on the fourth event (38 points, net margin 7 seconds) will beat a competitor winning the class by 1, 2, and 3 seconds with a 2 second deficit on the fourth event (38 points, net margin 4 seconds).
9. Trophies will be awarded for the first three places in the championship. Awards will be presented at the annual awards presentation evening.
