

Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd.
Victor Ludorum and Committee Cup Championship Rules
Issued April 2015

1. The championships will comprise all events run by Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd (WMC Ltd) in the club year, with the exception of the Boxing Day Taster event, and will only be open to members of WMC Ltd.
2. The championship year will run in line with the club year, from 1st October to 30th September.
3. The details of the championship administrator will be posted both in the club magazine and on the club web site.
4. Competitors are not required to register for the championships. All WMC Ltd members competing in WMC Ltd events who submit their entry under “WMC Ltd” and are shown as such in the entry list will be automatically entered into the Victor Ludorum Championship.
5. Scores from all events will count towards the championship.
6. Classes will be as determined for each event.
7. Competitors will score 5 points for first in class, 4 points for second in class, 3 points for third in class, 2 points for fourth in class and 1 point for fifth in class. Competitors finishing below fifth in class will still be recorded as having competed in a type of event for the purposes of Rule 10 below.
8. No extra points will be awarded for first overall in an event.
9. Competitors must compete in more than one type of event, and marshal or officiate at an event during the year in order to count in the overall classification at the end of the year.
10. Bonus points are awarded for competing in more than two types of event during a year. There will be 3 points added for competing in a third type, 5 added for competing in a fourth type and 7 added for competing in a fifth type.
11. Types of event are (i) trials, (ii) autotests (tarmac and grass) & autosolos, (iii) 4x4 trials, (iv) 12 car navigational rallies, (v) classic trial, (vi) speed event. The situation with autosolos may be reviewed in the future and made a separate category if there is enough interest. Further categories may be added at the discretion of the committee if new types of event arise.
12. The Committee Cup is awarded to the club member who has marshalled or officiated at club events on the most occasions during the club year. This will be recorded from the signing-on sheets for each event and shown as ‘M’ in the Victor Ludorum table.
13. Trophies will be presented at the WMC Ltd Annual Awards Function.
