SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd. will organise Clubmans 4x4 Trials on Saturday/**Sunday 19th Sept 2021 at Hogcliff**

Held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

1. Motorsports UK permit number – *****
2. The event is a round of the Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd 4x4 Trials Championship and is open to all fully elected members of Woolbridge Motor Club Ltd. and the Dorset Land Rover Club, who hold a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence (minimum RS Clubman).

Please go to <https://woolbridge.co.uk/2021-rs-clubman-licence/> for more information and a link to the online application – which is FREE OF CHARGE. Drivers and passengers, if carried, must both have competition licences.

3. There will be at least 6 sections, wholly on private land, and at least two runs will be allowed at each section.
4. The programme is as follows: - Entry to venue from 9am. First test at 1000hrs. Signing on will be online before the event
5. All vehicles must comply with MOTORSPORT UK Technical Regulations, section T11 to T11.14.4.
6. Classes: -
Class 1 - Any vehicle fitted with non-standard diff locks, fiddle brakes or non-standard suspension with lifts over 100mm. These vehicles must be fitted with full roll cages and will start with 10 penalty points.
Class 2 – Any vehicle with standard fitment diff locks, fiddle brakes; suspension lifts up to 100mm allowed. All caged buggies and tray-back vehicles. Max tyre size 285/75/16 or 35”
Class 3 – Any vehicles which retain at least 90% of bodywork as manufactured; no aftermarket diff locks or fiddle brakes allowed, maximum tyre size 235/85/16 or 33” tyre height.
7. The maximum entry for the event is 30. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes on the **Monday** before the event.
The entry fee is £20.00 per day. (Under 18's - £12 per day)
All entries must be made online and be accompanied by the entry fee.
NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OR AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.
All entries and payment will be via the Woolbridge online entry system due to Covid-19 requirements
Postal entries are not accepted.

9. All other General Regulations of the MOTORSPORT UK apply as written
10. No practising or unnecessary movement of cars will be allowed. Once a competitor's front wheels have crossed the start line of an observed section he / she will be deemed to have started the section.
11. No car may have more than two drivers.
12. Competition cars, except Class 3, need not have a current Road Fund Licence or MOT if required as the event is on private land.

13. In line with MOTORSPORT UK regulations, passengers in car trials are **not** mandatory. However, if a competitor starts the event with a passenger, they must retain the passenger for the event and vice versa. The seat alongside the driver, if occupied must comply with the following: -

4.1.5. Minimum Passenger ages are as follows:

Sporting Trials	14
Classic Reliability Trials	
Open or Convertible cars	14
Saloons or hardtop cars	12
Car Trials	12

It is the competitor's responsibility to provide such persons before the event.

14. No refreshments will be available on site – so please come prepared
15. Toilet facilities will be provided on site

PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ THE COVID RELATED INSTRUCTIONS BELOW

Please read these notes carefully. We are trying to adhere to all the relevant Government Rules (as they apply to England) and the guidance provided by Motorsport UK and the BTRDA, whilst trying to provide an enjoyable day's sport for everyone. Our aim is to keep everyone safe and to minimise or avoid any contact between competitors, marshals and other officials. In particular we want to avoid any transfer of paperwork/documentation between people on the day, so there will have to be some changes to the usual procedures. **Please note that if you are based in an area which is subject to local Covid-19 restrictions, you should assess whether these local rules will affect you.**

1. Make sure that you bring with you, as well as your normal equipment and food & drink, the following items:
- Your own face masks
 - Your own hand sanitiser/antiseptic wipes
 - Your Competition Number (will be emailed to you in advance)
 - A box of good humour

2. Electronic Forms

After the Closing Date, and prior to the event, you will be required to complete a Pre-event Declaration (takes the place of the signing-on Form), which will be found in the Woolbridge online system in the same place as the original entry form. This form will include a declaration that you have not been in contact with anyone showing Covid-19 symptoms in the previous 14 days, and will also include a self-declaration regarding scrutineering. (No scrutineering will take place on the day except for random tyre pressure and other checks). This must be completed by the Thursday before the event. Your Competition Number - you must print this (preferably on card) and secure it to your vehicle on arrival at the event site.

3. If you think you are showing any symptoms of Covid-19 immediately before the event, self- isolate and DO NOT attend the event. Please let the organisers know by phoning Secretary of the Meeting. If you need to withdraw under these circumstances, your Entry Fee will, of course, be refunded or carried forward to a future event.

4. Passengers/Car Sharing

Passenger	Masks to be worn in car?	Other actions needed
None	No	Use hand sanitiser often
Same household or bubble as driver, single or double entry	No	Use hand sanitiser often
Different household/bubble from driver – single entry	Yes	Use hand sanitiser often. Keep windows open.
Different household/bubble from driver – double entry	Yes	Keep windows open. Use hand sanitiser after each swap. Use antiseptic wipes to wipe steering wheel; gear lever; hand brake; door handles and any other frequently touched surfaces after each round.

5. Do not encourage marshals to approach within 2 metres of your car.
6. Please observe social distancing (2 metres) throughout the day whenever outside your car.
7. Do not touch other competitors' cars; any marker posts or other equipment placed by the organisers.
8. Masks may be worn at any time if you wish, but you do not have to wear a mask or other PPE except as described in 4 above or if, for some reason, social distancing cannot be observed.
9. Please note that **ONLY** competitors and officials of the event will be allowed onto the site. No spectators/media can be admitted.
10. Procedures on the day. When you arrive at the site, please report to the secretary of the meeting so that he/she knows you have arrived. Keep 2 metres away and do not exchange any paper documents. Your Competition Licence(s) and Club Membership Card(s) should be shown to the secretary while maintaining social distancing. All competitors must bring them to the event, even if you have emailed them.
