The seventy-two year old had a passion for Aston Martins, with a sizeable personal collection, but then took his passion a large step further when, in 2007, he led a consortium buy-out of the prestige car manufacturer from Ford. The compay has subsequently been sold to a syndicate with Canadian Lawrence Stroll at the helm. In addition to MSUK and Prodrive Richards and his wife Karen have two hotels in Cornwall where he has run into a spot of trouble with the locals who are not terribly keen on his helicopter coming and going.
